Christian Exiles Are Fleeing Persecution

When the first white settlers crossed the Blue Mountains and settled in what is now known as South Manheim Township, Schuylkill County, they brought with them their faith and loyalty to God. In the midst of their trying experiences of settling in a wilderness that was inhabited by Indians, they

"looked to the hills from whence came their help" and on the top of the Summer Hill they founded and built their house of worship. This church dates back to the days preceding the Revolutionary War, and the Declaration of Independence.

From its origin until 1959, St. Paul's was a union church, alternating services with it's neighboring Lutheran congregation. In December 1958, fire destroyed the old Union Church, whereupon, each congregation built its own place of worship.
