Chester County Migrant Ministries Donations Drive

Most of these migrants live and work yearround in the area, and they arrive with very little to their names. Typically, they come unprepared for the colder northern temperatures. In addition, the majority have not learned English, which makes it difficult to ask for help and receive various services. Palm Schwenkfelder Church participates in the annual drive to collect basic necessities. Palm Schwenkfelder Mission Board would like to invite you to participate in our annual drive, from **May 7-14**, **2017**. Current needs include:

Health Kits: Toothbrushes/toothpaste, bath towels, wash cloths, disposable razors, soap (Ivory, med. size), pocket mirrors, toilet paper, plastic coffee cups, heavy plastic ware, shaving cream, combs and women's feminine products.
Other items needed: new/used blankets (used blankets must be clean and in good condition), first aid kits, paperbacks, Spanish/English dictionaries, and Bibles. Please place all items at the Migrant Ministry Display by Sunday, May 14, 2017. Furthermore, a list of necessities will be posted on the Mission Board's information center in the Narthex. Thank you for your assistance, as all donations are welcomed and greatly appreciated. "Share your food with the hungry, and give shelter to the homeless. Give clothes to those who need them, and do not hide from relatives who need your help." Isaiah 58:7.



Wonderful Happenings at Love in Action United Church of Christ



On January 22nd, 2017, the congregation known as the United Church of Christ in Warminster finally found their new home at 350 S. York Rd. in Hatboro, PA after searching for more than a year and a half. The multi-use building will serve as a place for worship, education, social services, partnerships, and community.

Shortly thereafter, at a congregational meeting, the community voted to change the name of the congregation to Love In Action United Church of Christ, an Opening and Affirming Congregation.





In the few months since the change, the community has been blessed with many visitors, new members, numerous children, and an influx of young adults. LIAUCC also currently hosts a bi-weekly LGBTQIA meetup group for support, advocacy, and community-building.

On April 13th during Holy Week LIAUCC hosted Muslims, Jews, Christians, Hindus, non-religious folk and others for an Interfaith dinner catered and co-hosted by Syrian families settling in Bucks and Montgomery Counties.
