Meet the nominee for UCC General Minister and President

The Rev. John C. Dorhauer, nominee for general minister and president, believes the United Church of Christ has a relevant message of love and inclusivity that the world will find hard to ignore. He believes that our small but mighty denomination, in partnership with the Holy Spirit, is a voice that is sorely needed in the faith community and as part of his leadership he looks forward to making it heard.

Dorhauer, the current conference minister of the Southwest Conference of the UCC, was approved as the nominee to become the denomination's ninth general minister and president in March by the UCC Board of Directors.

Approval by delegates of the 30th General Synod (taking place June 26-30 in Cleveland) is the final step in confirming Dorhauer's candidacy. That vote must pass with a 60 percent majority to make him the leader who would take the church of nearly 1 million members into the future.

Dorhauer, who pledges a closer relationship between the national leadership and the local church, also advocates for partnerships with organizations sharing the same message as the UCC.

Bethany UCC Ministry in Haiti

Bethany United Church of Christ, in NE Philadelphia, is partnering with Christian Fellowship for a ministry trip to Haiti. Christian Fellowship is a robust Haitian congregation with Pastor Sem Pierre as their spiritual leader. Among their many Christian endeavors is an annual mission trip to Haiti. The intent of this annual mission project is to promote human development and Christian education through the donation of relief, medical and educational supplies and equipment. They assist the people of Haiti on the basis of need, NOT creed, gender, race or birth place. This year will be no different. What will be different is that the 2015 mission project, which will run from July 18 to 25, will include seven members of Bethany United Church of Christ!

Through a number of fund raisers, Bethany United Church of Christ has been able to donate 200 book-bags complete with school supplies, 100 tote bags filled with baby items, various medical supplies, such as stethoscopes, bandages, sterile masks and gloves, alcohol wipes and band-aides. We also donated \$2,000 to off set the shipping costs of these items to Haiti.

The seven volunteers from Bethany will be working to spread God's word while staffing a medical clinic, teaching a Vacation Bible School, conducting an adult Bible study, and supplying manual labor as needed. The seven volunteers, with the full support of the entire Bethany congregation, are looking to forward to working with our Haitian sisters and brothers from Christian Fellowship to bring relief and the word of God to the people of Haiti. Five years ago Bethany United Church of Christi invited Christian Fellowship to use Bethany as their church home. This has truly turned into a "match made in heaven!"
