Other items needed: new/used blankets (used blankets must be clean and in good condition), first aid kits, paperbacks, Spanish/English dictionaries, and Bibles. PSEC Representatives Attending General Synod 30

Every two years, General Synod brings together thousands of faithful members of the United Church of Christ for formal church witness, inspirational worship, and fellowship with friends (new and old). In June 2015, thousands from across the country (and abroad) will gather for General Synod 30 in Cleveland, Ohio — the birthplace of the United Church of Christ. Together, we will discern resolutions of witness, church structure, and function.

Thirty five delegates are preparing to represent Pennsylvania Southeast Conference on a wide range of issues and resolutions affecting our Christian witness locally and globally. You can read more about the issues at **synod.uccpages.org**.

In addition to their participation, **Beth Walker**, member of the Philadelphia Association and Chair of the UCC Governance Committee, will present changes to the UCC Constitution and Bylaws for Synod approval. Several changes to that document have potential implications for the way we organize and conduct our work at the national level.

The **Manual on Ministry Re-visioning Team**, of which I am a member, will make its first presentation of the work that it is doing.

Dwayne Royster, founding Pastor of Living Water UCC in Philadelphia, will preach at the Sunday worship ("Handing on the Mantle") and...

Nathanael Vissia, Director of Christian Education, at UCC Valley Forge, will be leading a workshop titled, "Youth and Sunday School: We Can Do Better."

Also, some of the General Synod 30 participants will *stuff the packs*. "**Stuff the Pack**" is a national UCC call to congregations, civic groups, and businesses to collect school supplies to prepare backpacks that will be distributed to children within the Cleveland Municipal School District by our community partner, University Settlement.

Please pray for our Conference delegates as they stand up for issues that demand a faithful witness and join together in worship as you are gathered now to lift up our United voices to the Stillspeaking God.
