





One of my duties as an Annuitant Visitor for the Pension Board is to maintain contact with approximately fifty retired ministers and/or spouses. While visiting these minister and spouses, I am in a position to recommend special gifts for people who have special needs and unmet services. Mrs. Shirley Johnson - My husband and I served the churches in various settings for 64 years. Those years were challenging and rewarding. Rev. Jack Ivey It wasn't until I was on the receiving end of the Christmas Fund Offering that the true nature of the ministry became clear. I live with a cancer of the bone marrow plasma cells. Last winter the disease reached a point where more active treatment was needed in the form of a clinical trial. It was at that point when a check arrived, a gift made possible by the special Christmas Fund Offering. At a time when expenses mounted, that gift paid for gas, parking, and incidental expenses for twice weekly trips to Philadelphia. It enabled me to participate in the clinical trial. What years ago meant just an occasion for writing a check, being on the receiving end of that ministry made those therapies possible. I have a sincere appreciation for the Church's thoughtfulness. You make a difference in making this ministry possible. Thank you.

As you can see, it is important that we continue to support this special fund for those who need it. Jesus calls us to care for those in need, and what better time than at Christmas! *Contributions to the Christmas Fund Offering will be received on Sunday, December 20, or whenever possible.*
